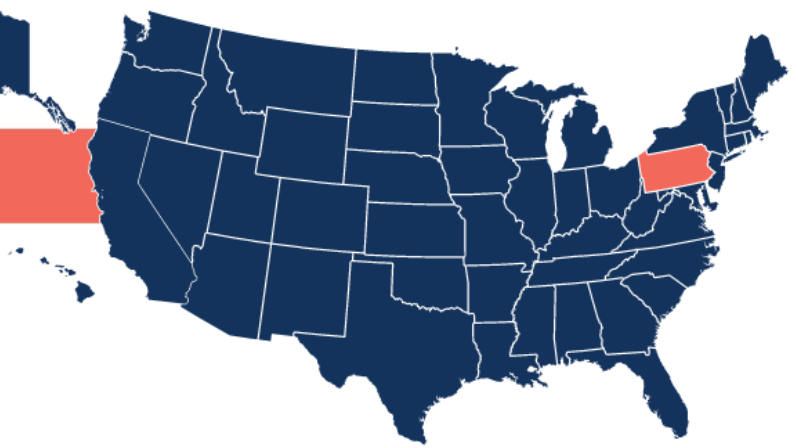

Broadband Programs

- The [Pennsylvania Broadband Development Authority](#) (PBDA) is developing the state's broadband plan and distributes federal and state funding.
- [Pennsylvania Broadband Development Authority Kicks off Public Listening Session Tour in North Philadelphia](#)
- [PennState Extension's broadband map](#) shows numerous locations where download speeds of 25 Mbps are unavailable.
- In partnership with PennState Extension, the PBDA submitted over 50,000 service availability challenges to the FCC in January, over 17,000 of which were accepted.

Community Perspectives

- In October 2021, the [City of Philadelphia](#) released the [results](#) of its Household Internet Assessment Survey. 42% of over 2500 residents revealed that affordability (such as the monthly fee or computer cost) was the most important reason they do not have high-speed service at home. 75% of low-income residents said over \$20/month for internet access would be too high.
- The [Philadelphia Federal Reserve Bank](#) found that 10% of households (533,575 homes) in the Commonwealth do not have a computer or smartphone with data.
